




4 Year Funding Overview






FY 17 Support by Agency Type






FY 17 Support by Sponsor/Activity






Top Federal Funding Agencies






FY 17 Awards by College/Division



Update on SPA Initiatives




- Enhance funding development
 - Expand professional development series to include parallel funding development and grant administration tracks
 - Internal cross-training of SPA staff build out expertise
- Update or develop policies to reflect current institutional structure and funding climate
 - Core facilities and recharge centers
 - External funding classifications (Foundation, Outreach, and SPA)
- 3. Streamline business processes to reduce administrative burden
 - Implemented electronic proposal routing
 - System integration and functionality

Summary



- 1. University funding portfolio is changing to reflect current institutional priorities and program alignment.
