

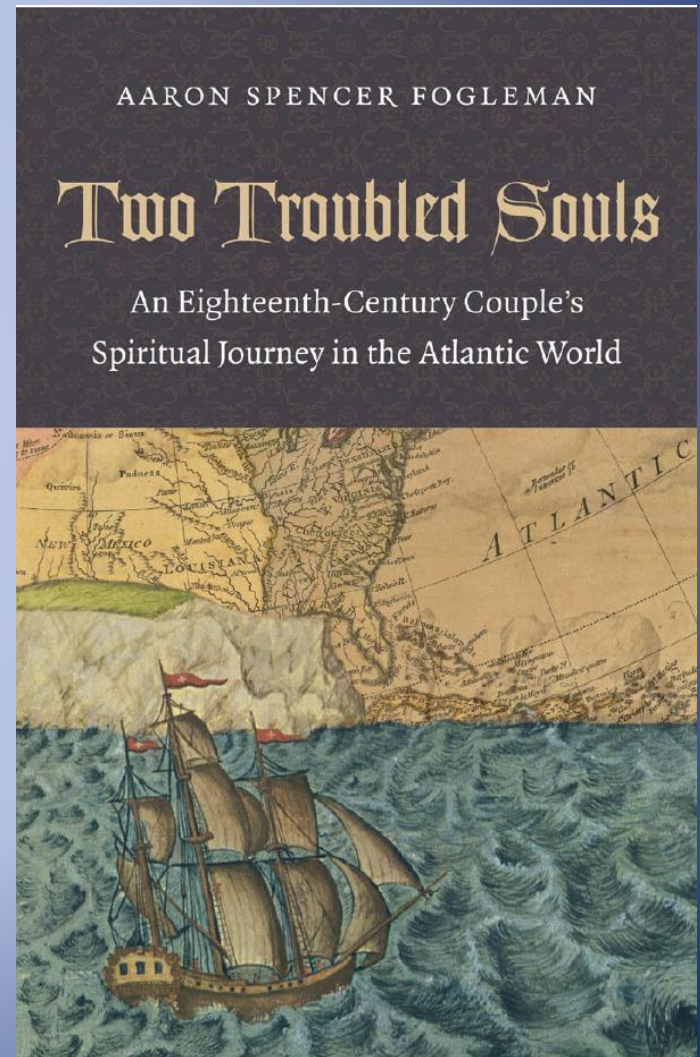

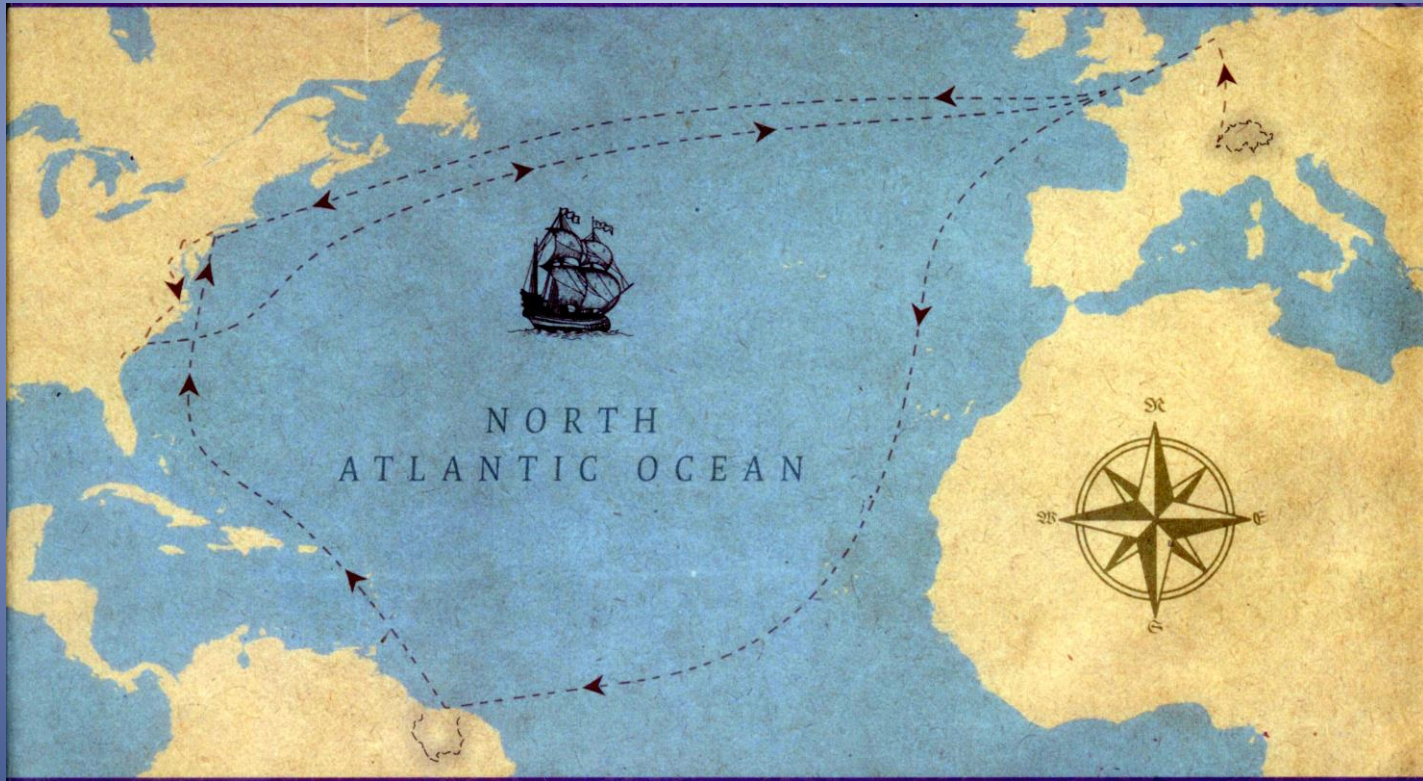

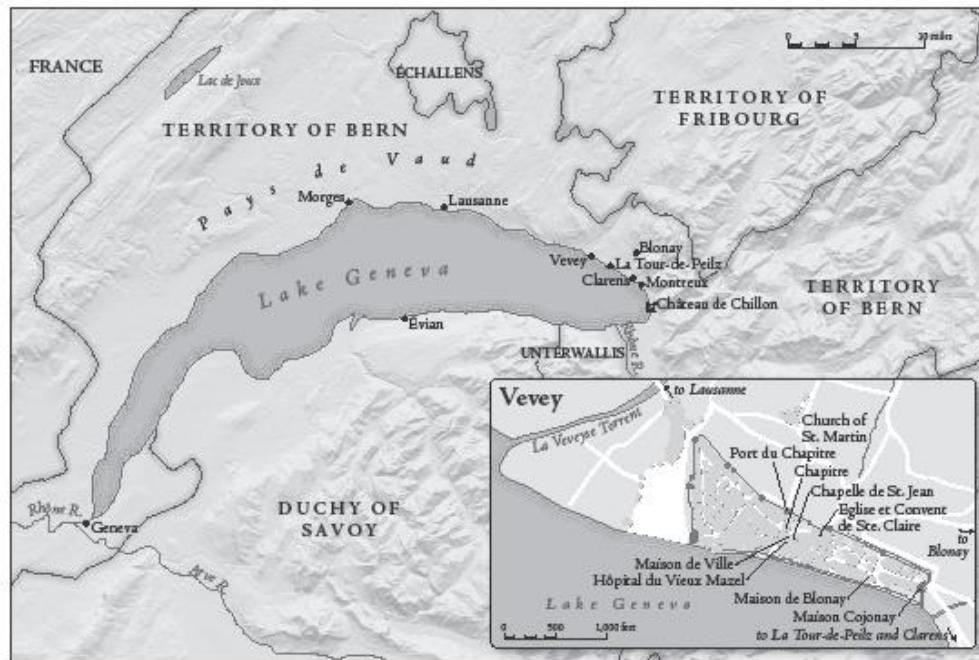
Career Impact of the Book

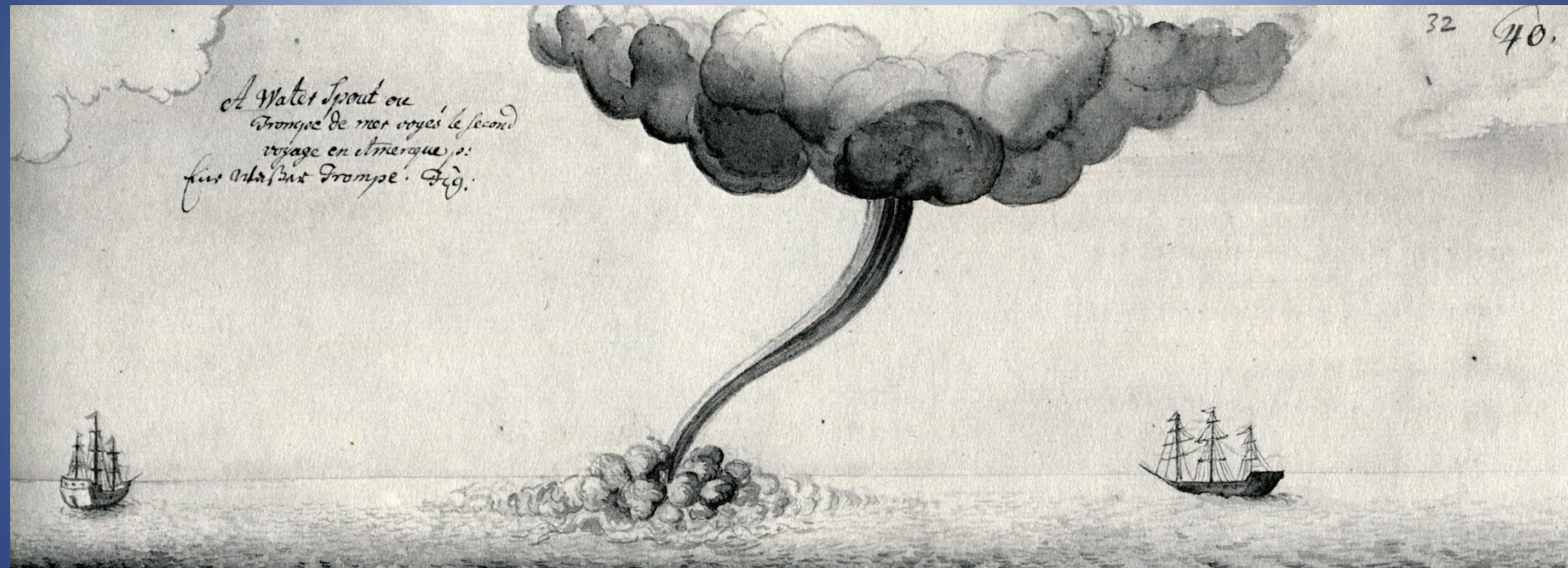

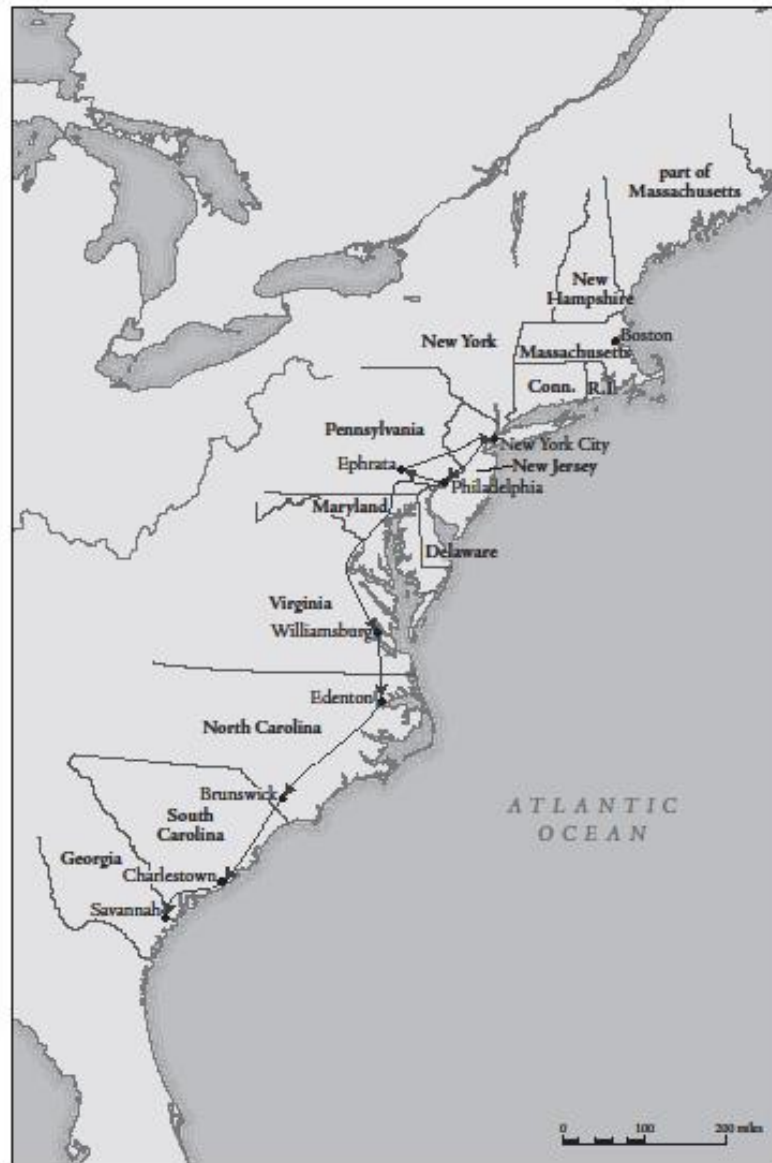


Baron von Reck's water color on the mid-Atlantic, 1736



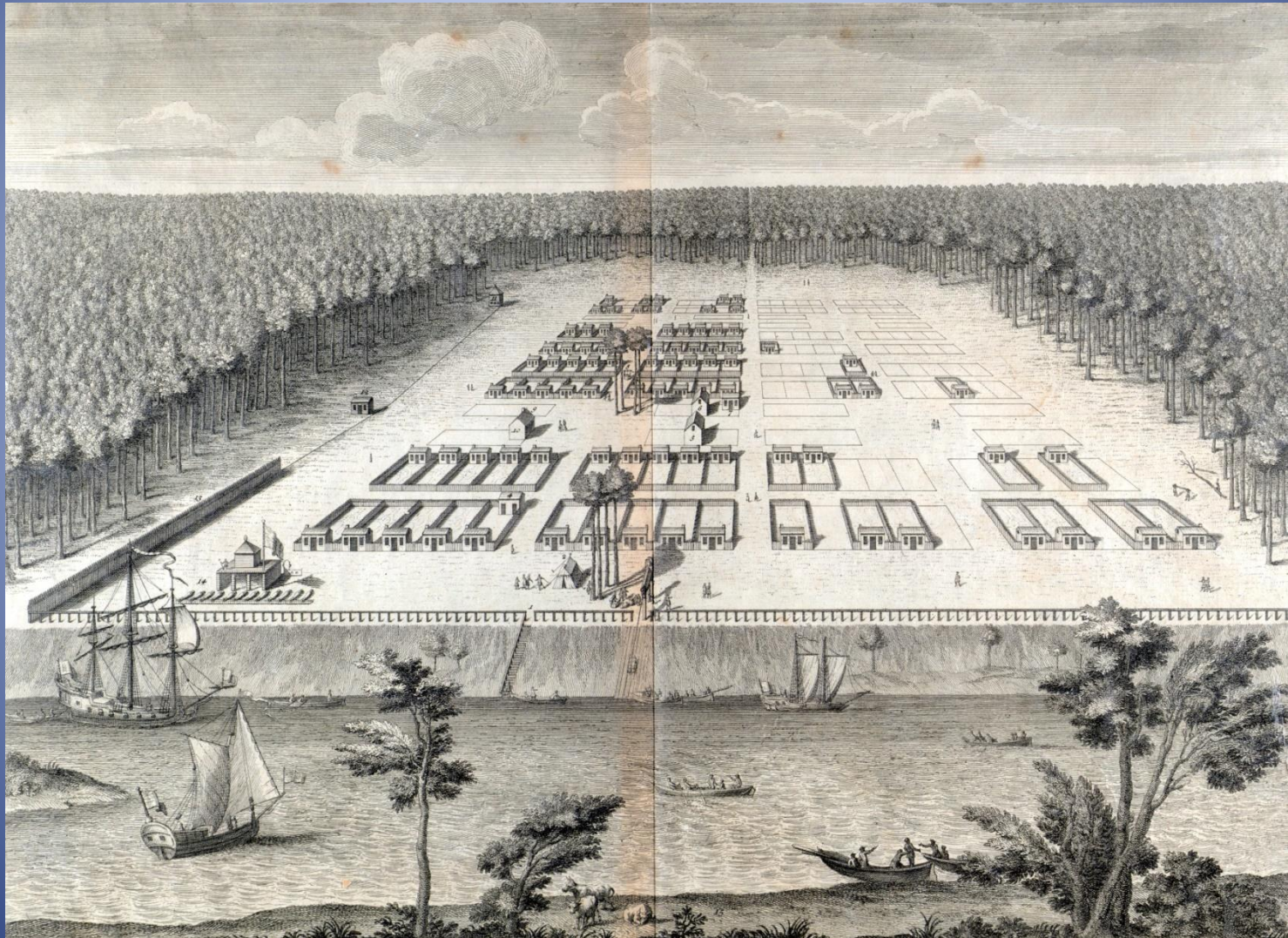

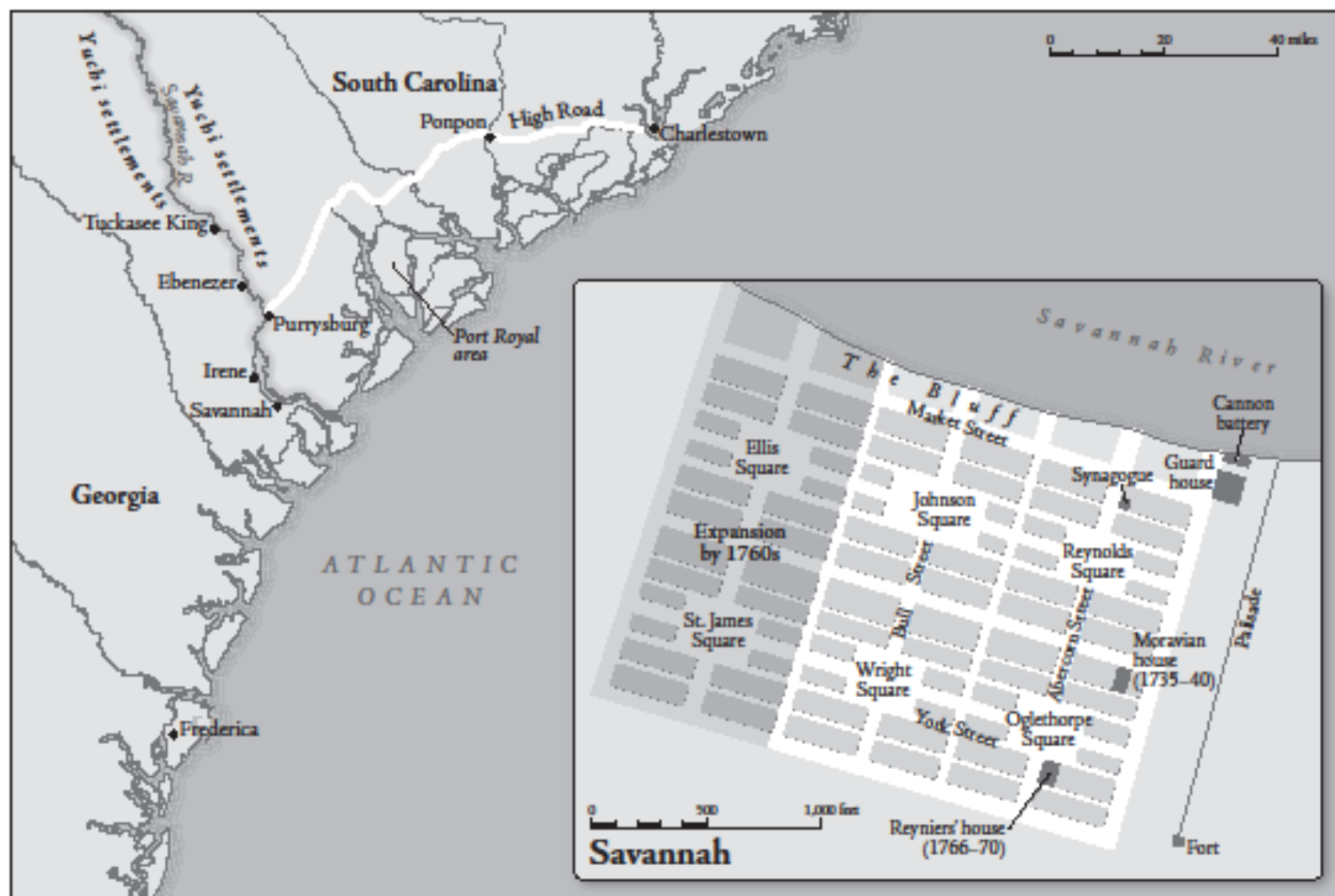


Von Reck's watercolor of a Yuchi village near Savannah, Georgia, 1736



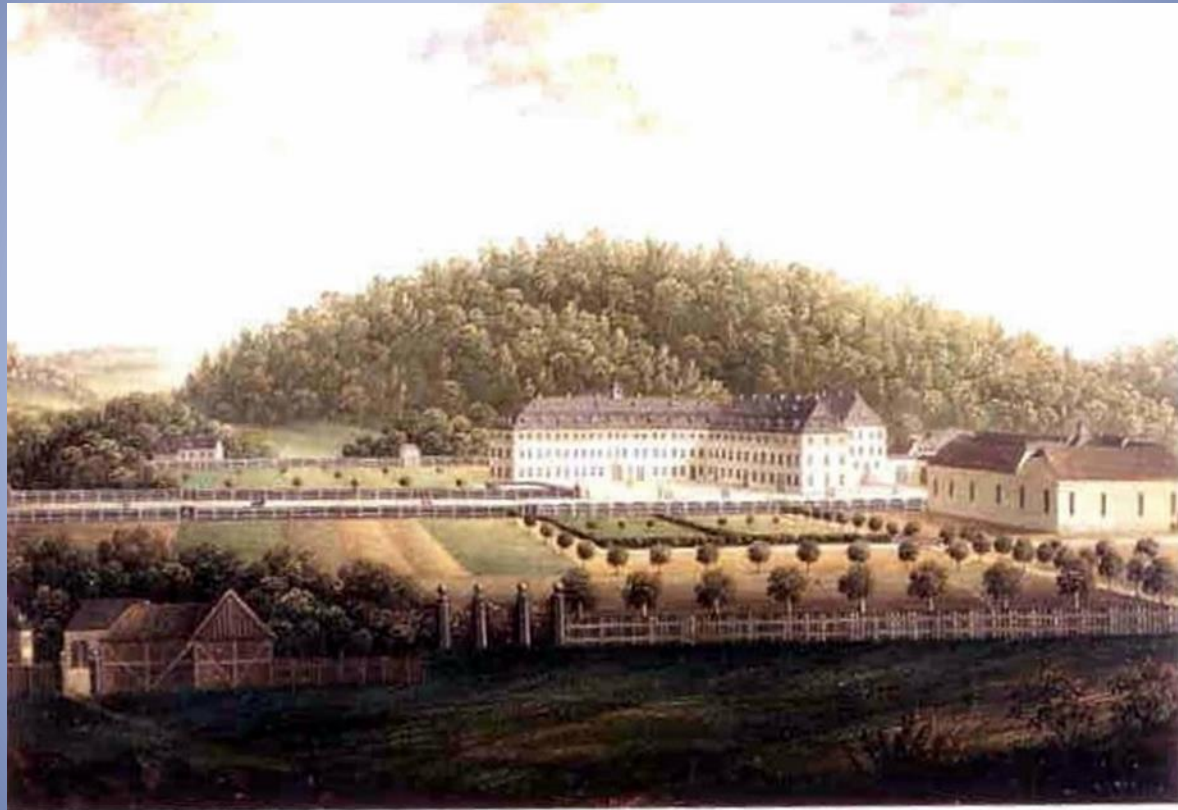

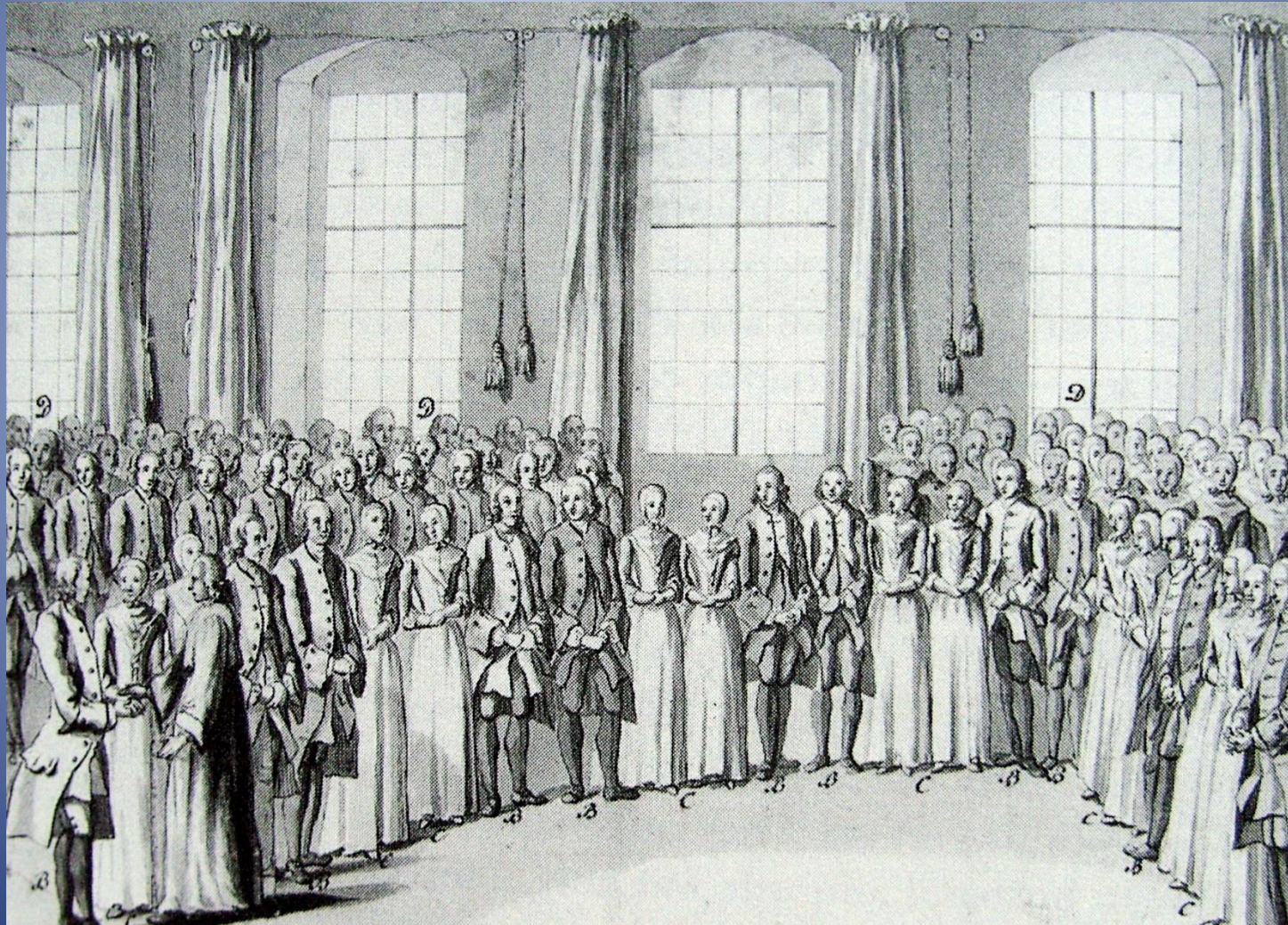

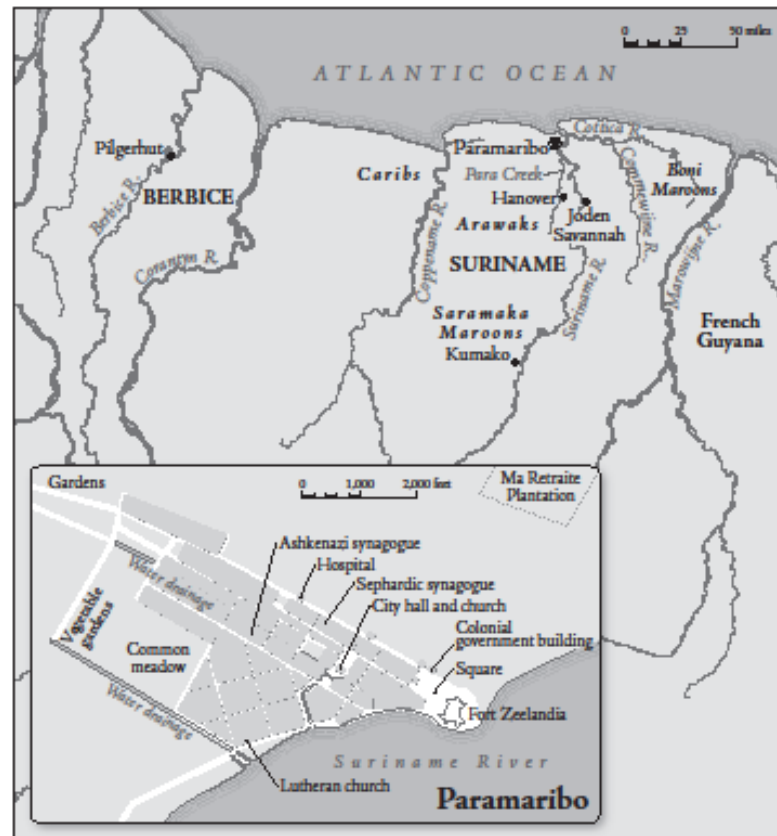


Paramaribo, Suriname, 18th century

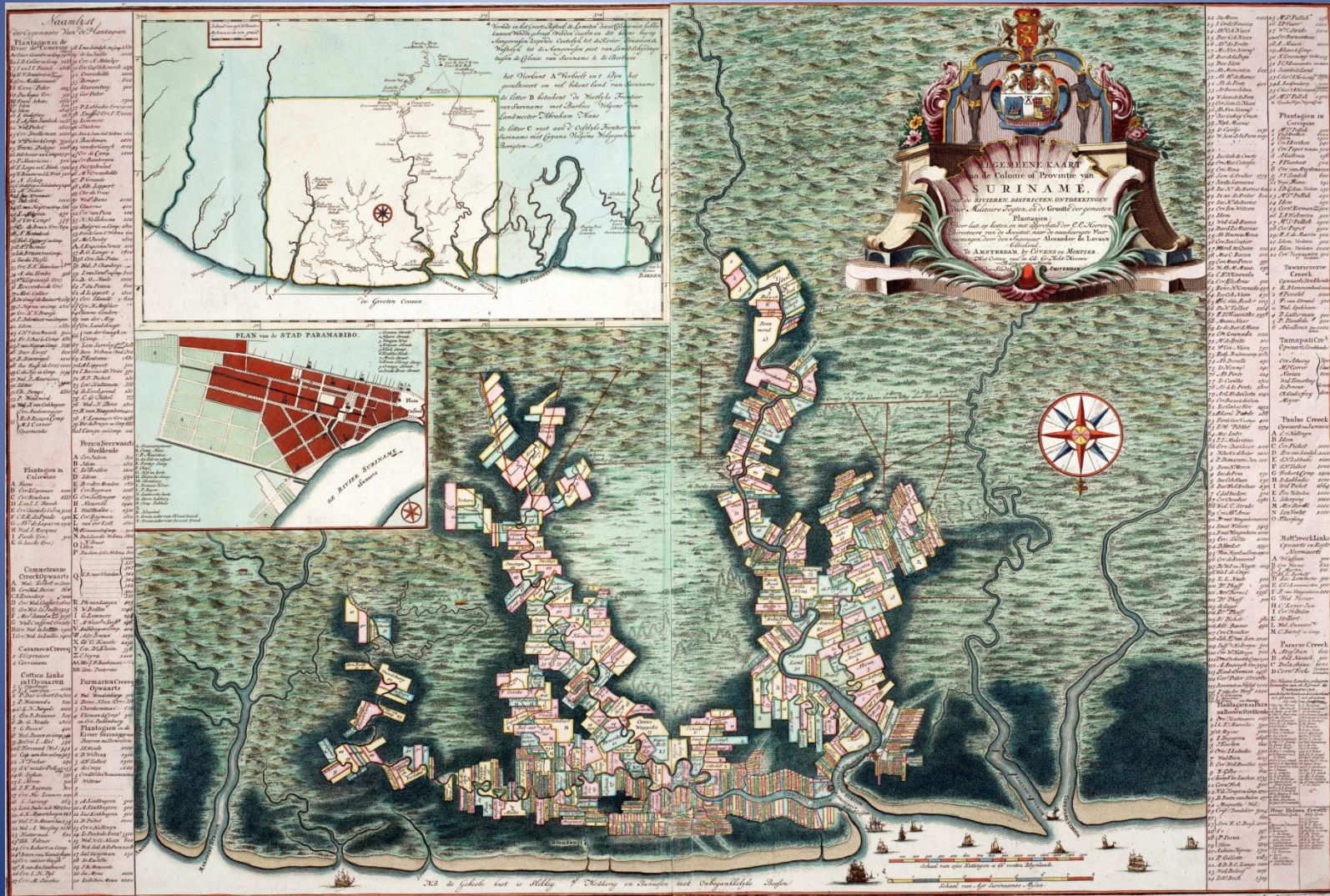

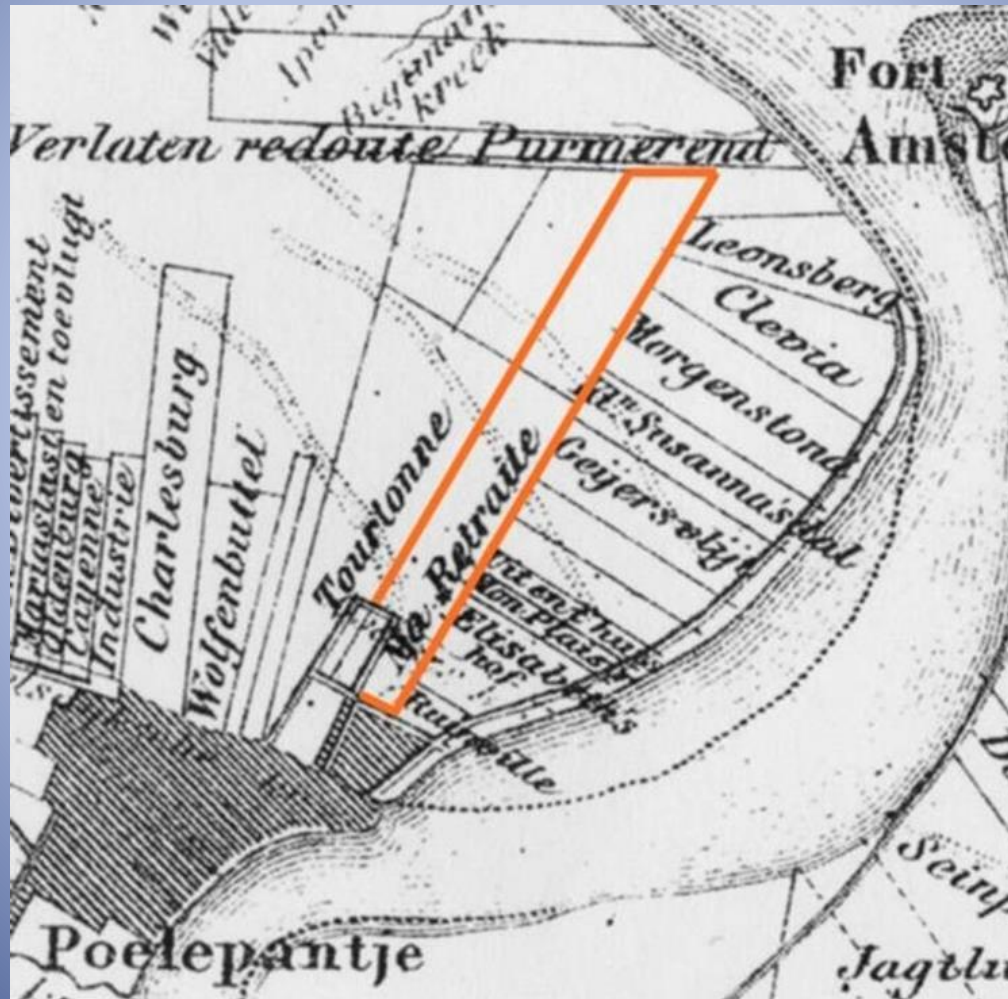

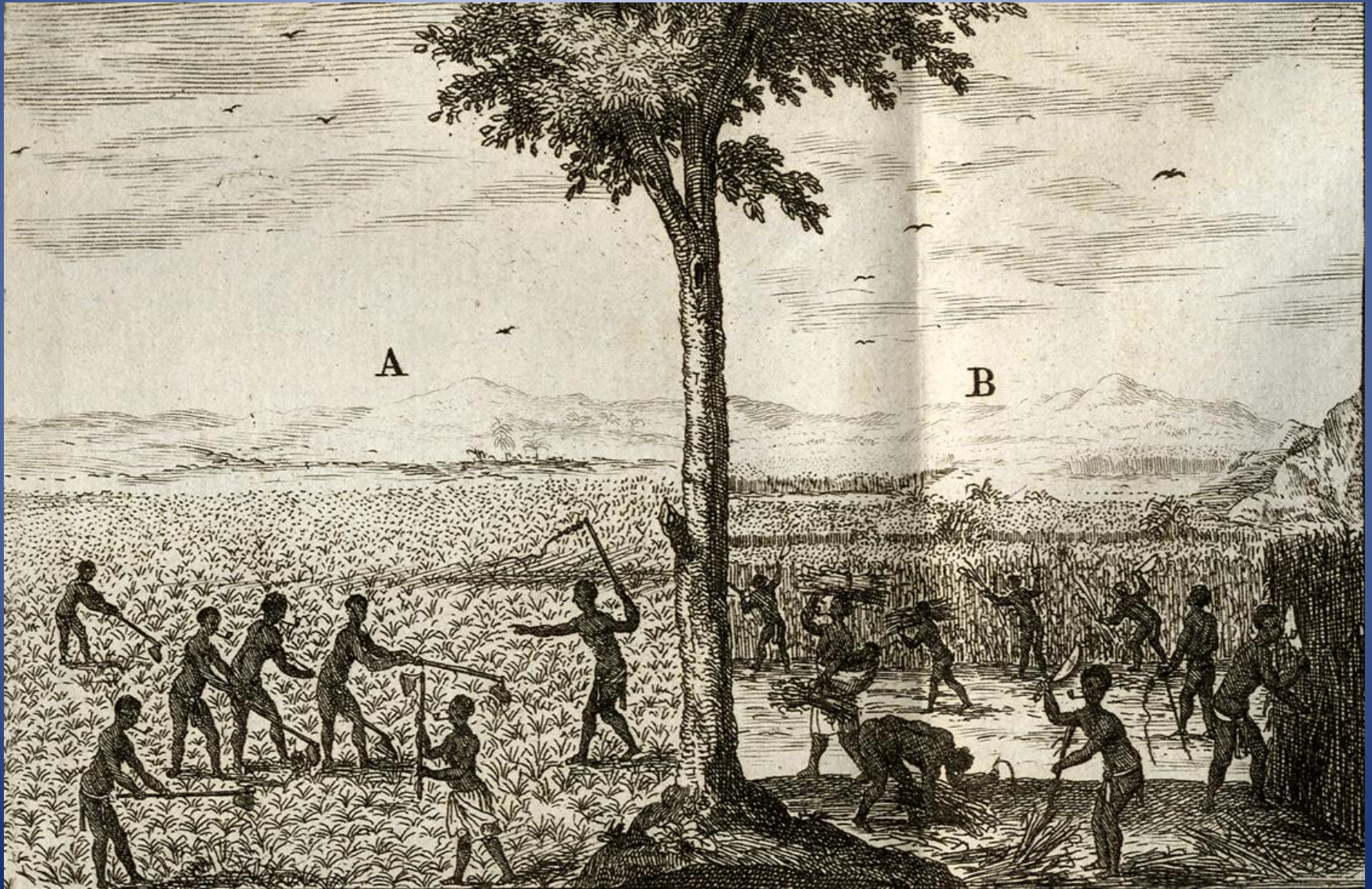


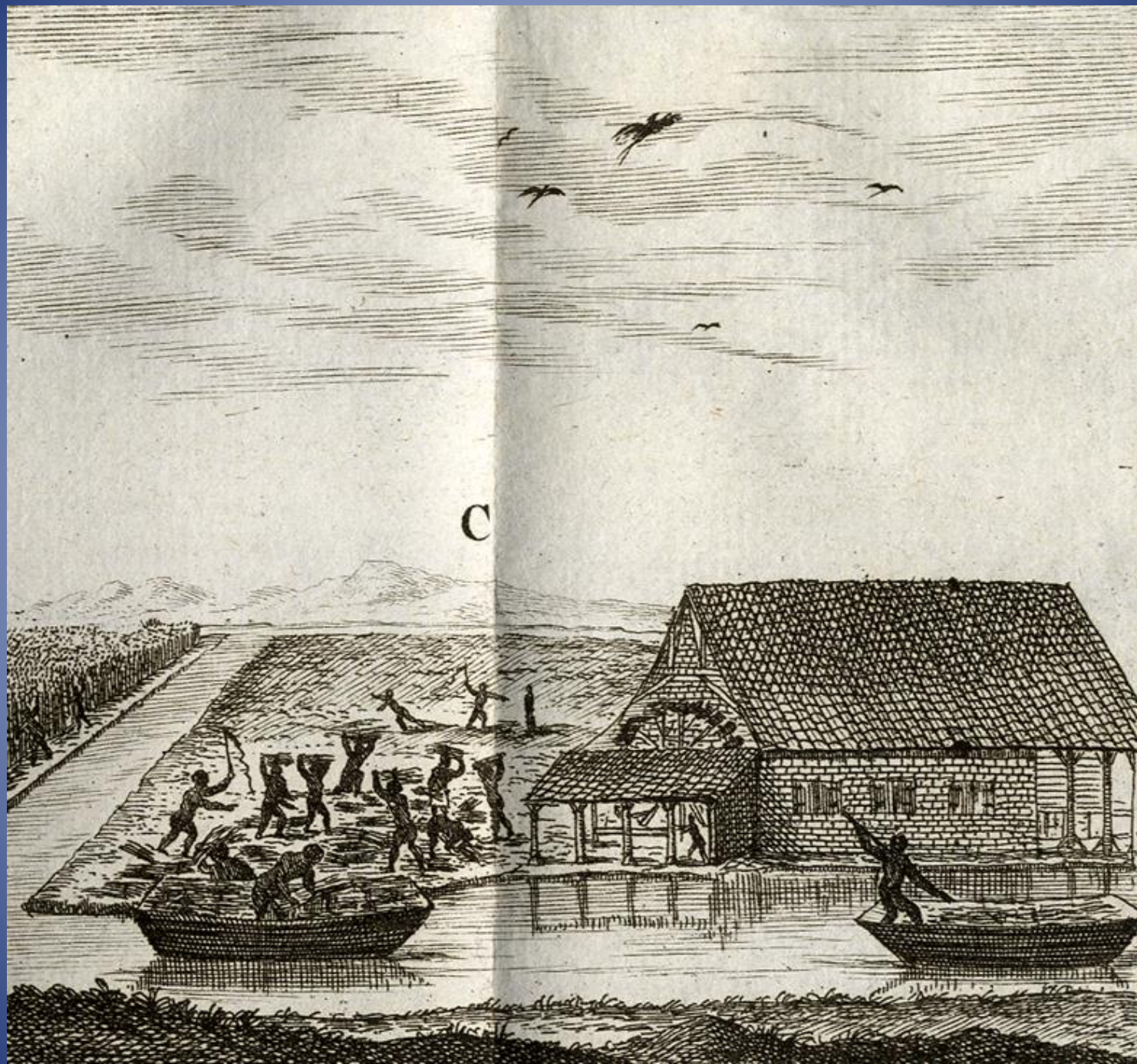

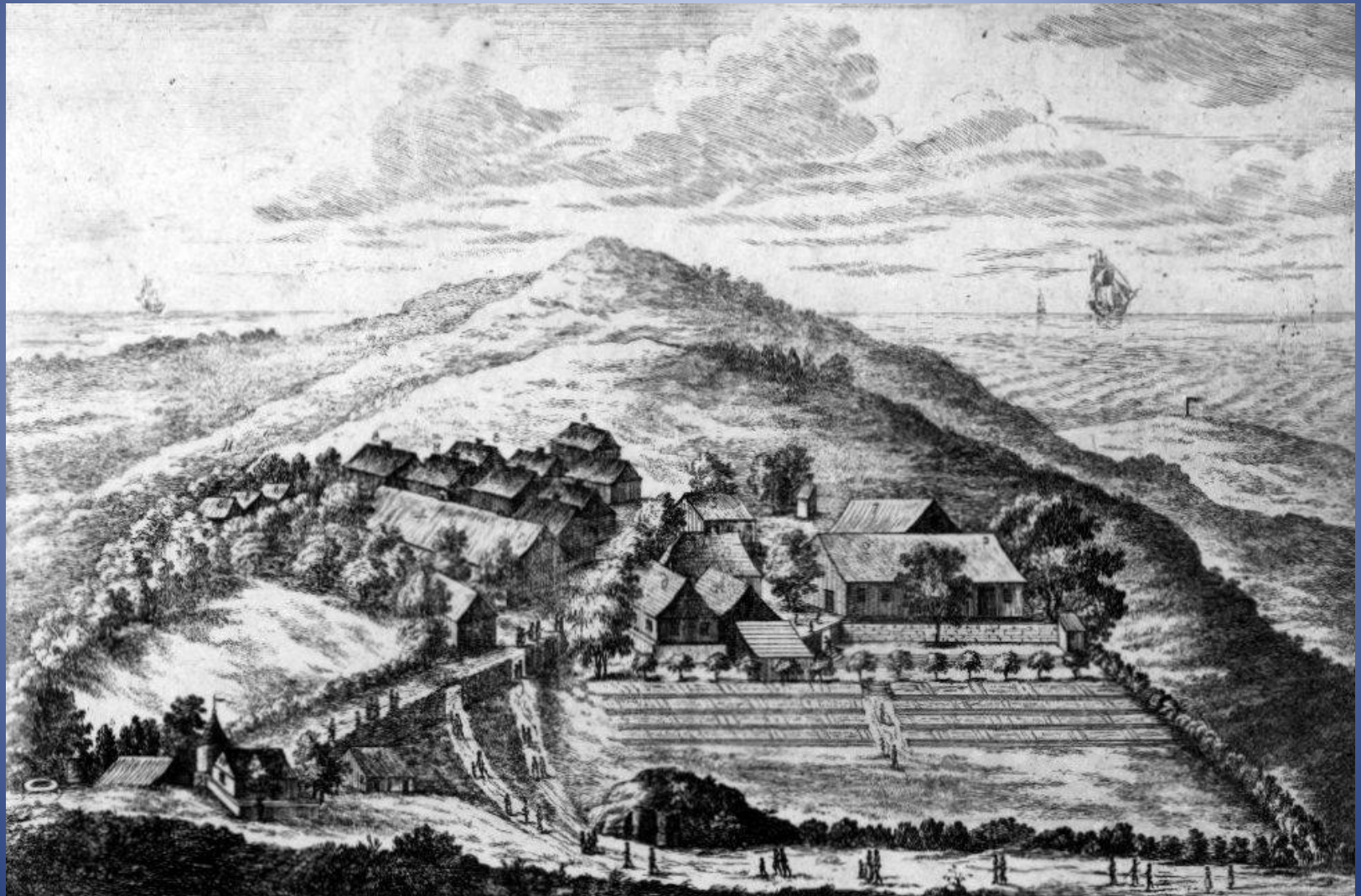

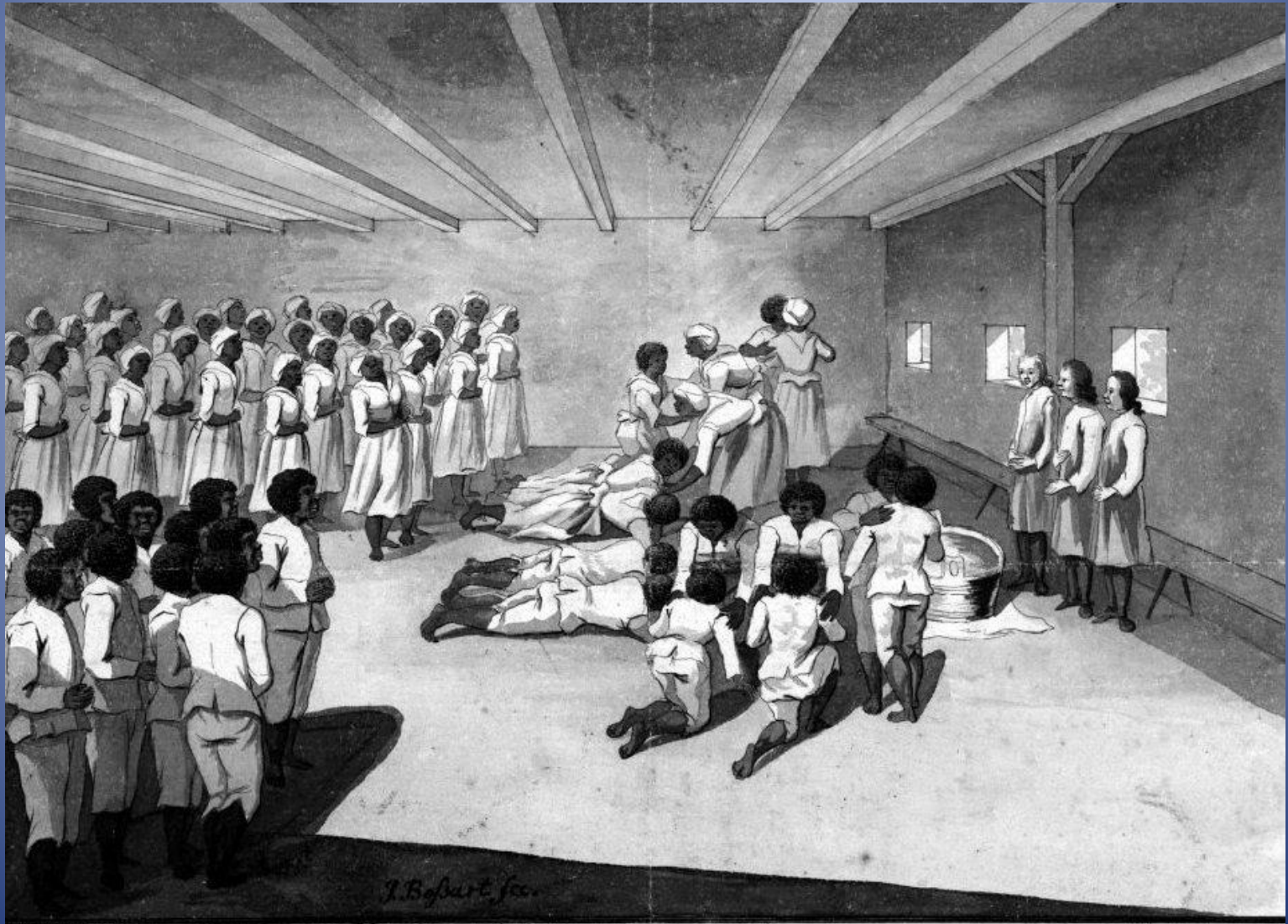
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Posaunenberg, Moravian plantation on St. Thomas, 18th century



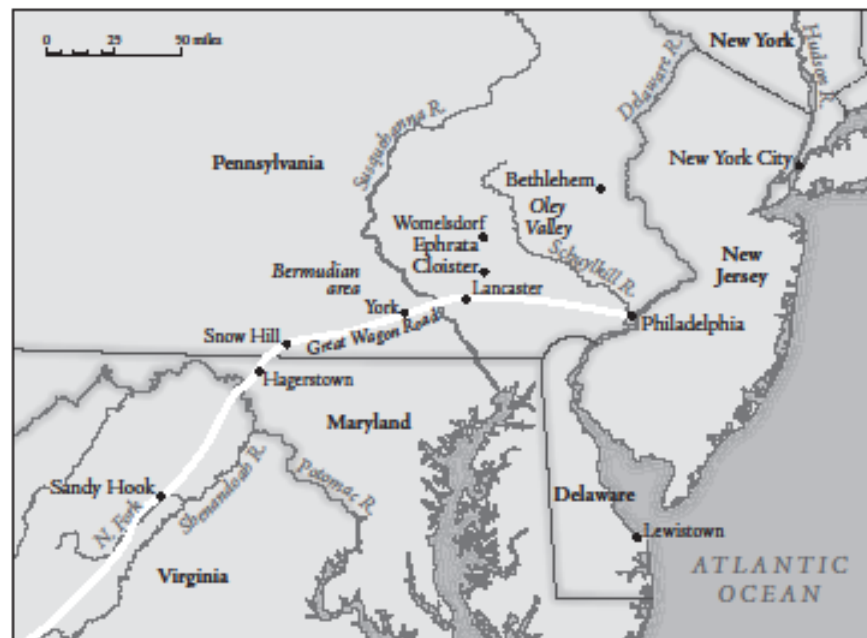

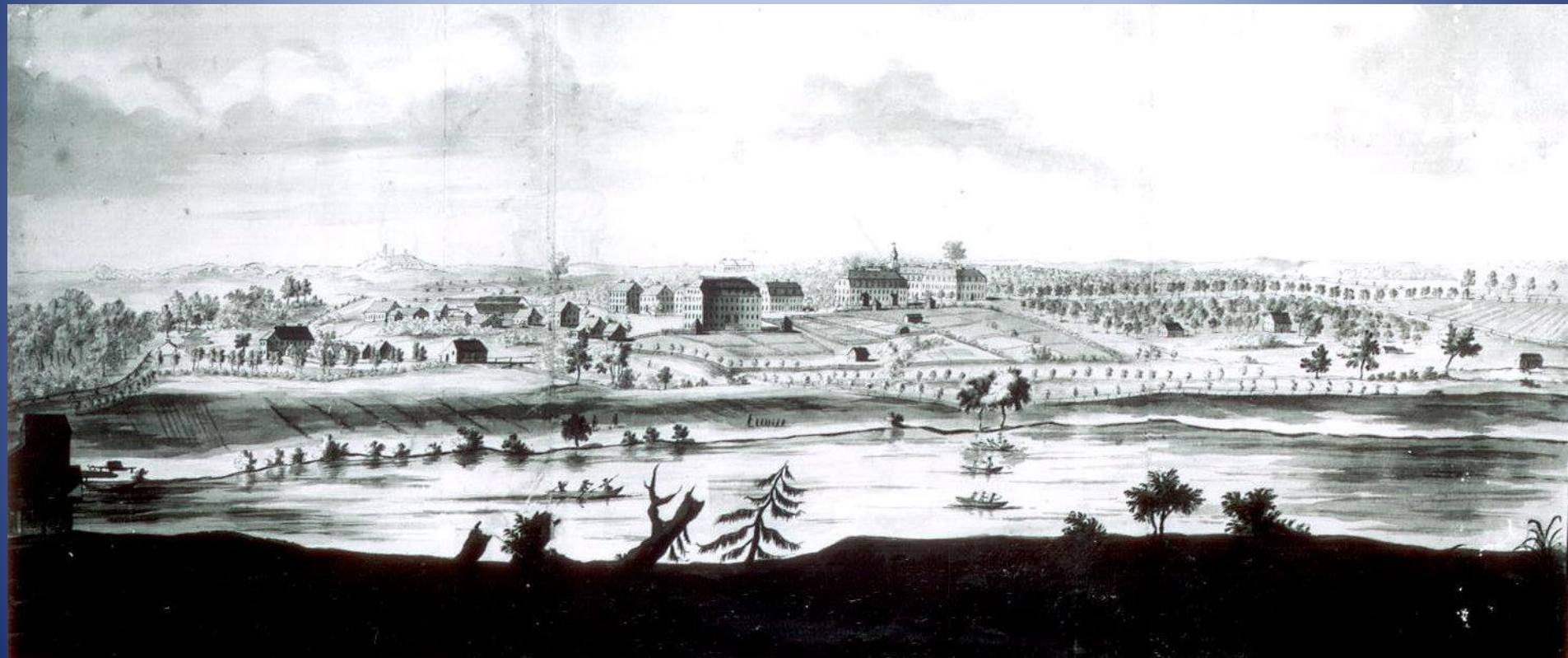




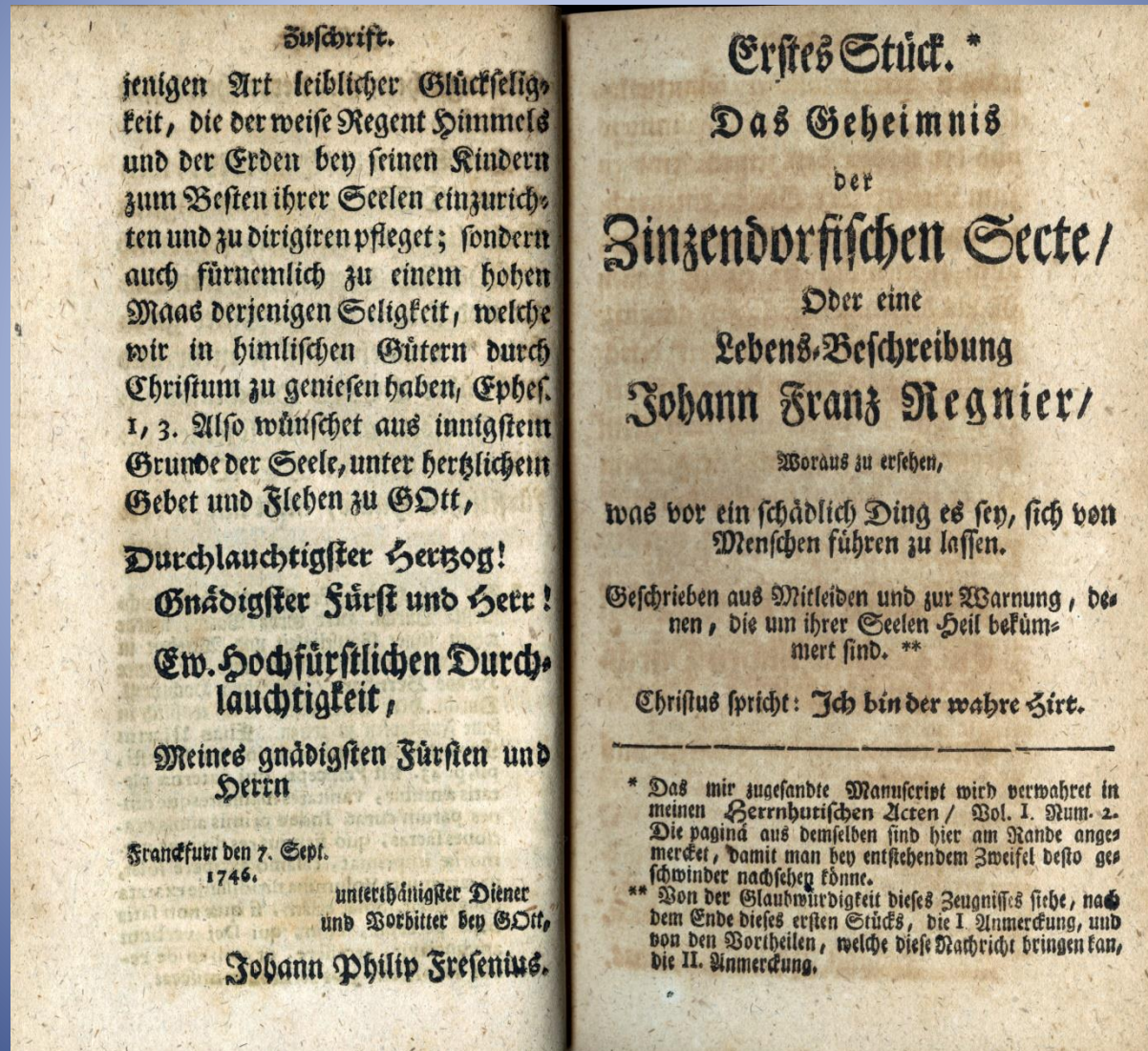

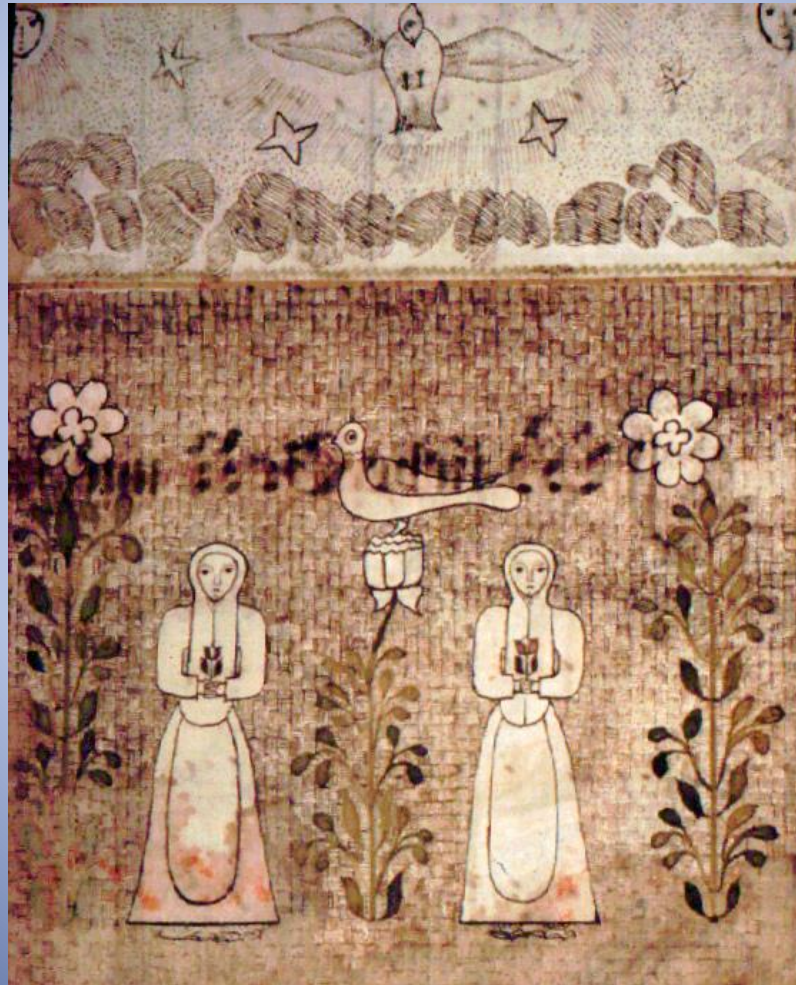

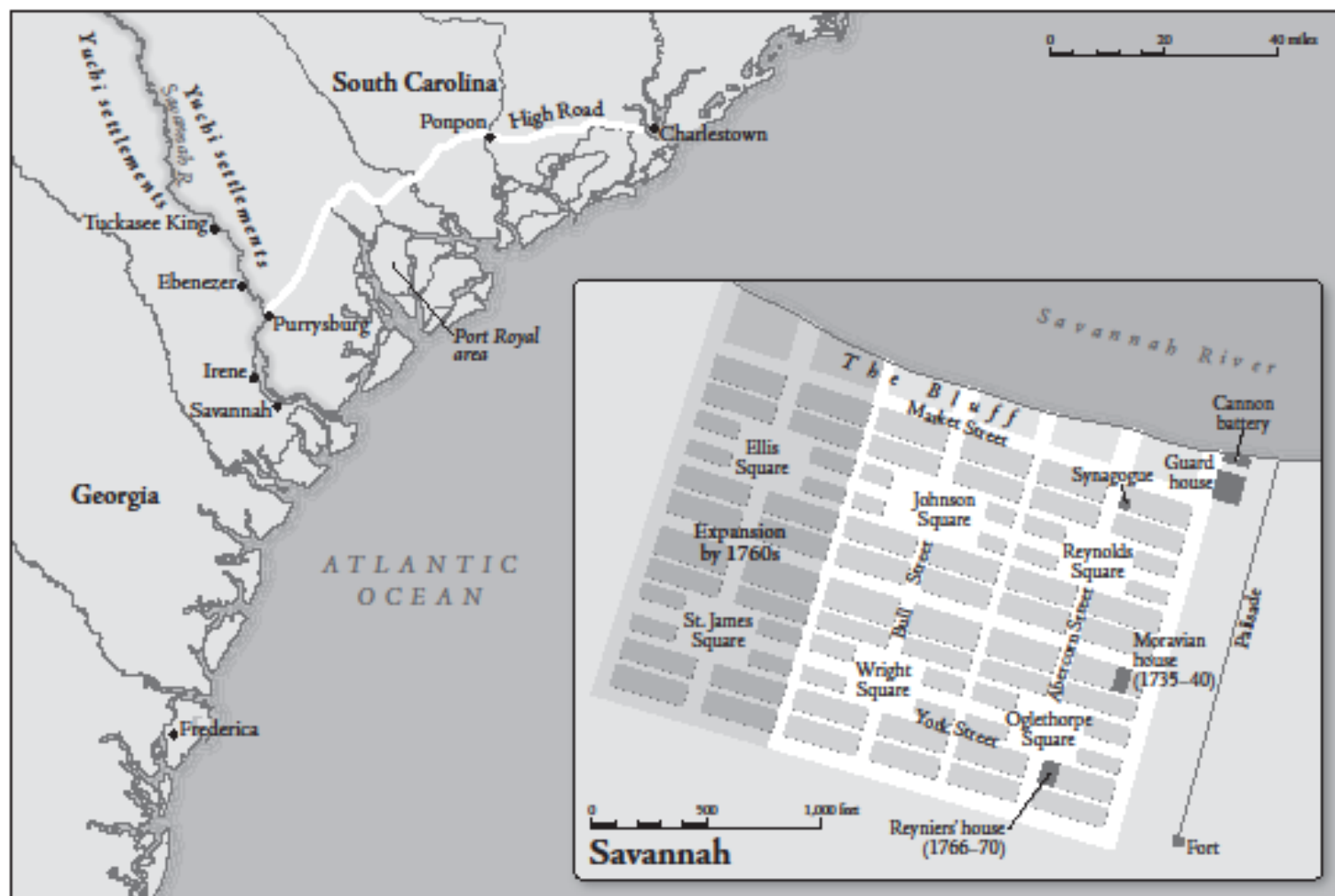
